



## Sports Premium 2019-20

Sports Premium Funding is money that is being provided by central government to improve the quality of Sport and PE in Primary Schools. Sports funding for our school for 2019-2020 is £18,600

### **At our school the money is being used in the following ways:**

- 1) To give staff an opportunity to work alongside PE specialists to improve quality of PE lessons raise fitness levels
- 2) To provide staff with high quality CPD so they can deliver the range of PE to a very high quality
- 3) To develop lunchtime physical and sporting opportunities for all age groups in order to increase children opportunities to participate in physical activities across lunch times
- 4) To increase participation across the school in physical learning opportunities in order to develop healthy lifestyles in our pupils.

Funding to support swimming across the school so that all KS 2 children achieve national expectation by end of year 6	£4440
